**EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR’S REPORT**

The Updated Pollution Reduction Plan (PRP) Revision #6, which includes updates and additions required by DEP Representative Paul Grella, were reviewed and submitted to DEP for review.

Since the last Board meeting, the region received several rain events which created a situation where increased flows from Harvey’s Lake and limited flows into Wyoming Valley Sanitary Authority (WVSA), resulted in limited EQ tank overflows, which were reported to DEP. Additionally, the inflow pipe to the EQ tank was found to be rotted, even though it was only four years old. An outside contractor was called in and the line was replaced with a new plastic pipe and weatherization expansion joint. Brent Berger is reviewing the original installation specifications to determine why the pipe used wasn’t treated or coated internally.

A site meeting with UGI for the Overbrook Project was cancelled by UGI. Brent Berger and the site contractor are trying to get a final plan in place to meet the UGI requirements and complete the Overbrook Project.

A meeting was held on April 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2026, with WVSA to review their application for Federal Monies to complete the River Crossing Project and continue work on updating the DAMA/WVSA Intergovernmental Cooperation Agreement. DAMA agreed to work with WVSA to put together a Power-Point presentation, which can be presented to Federal and State Officials outlining the critical nature of completing the river crossing project, and the financial and physical dangers of not upgrading the river crossing.
